Welcome to a brand-new decade of rhythmic gymnastics! Here's all the latest information from our club.

#### **Age Groups and Classes**

Our recreation and elite classes are split into Beginners (new starters & U8), Espoir (ages U9 – U12), Junior (ages U13, U14, U15) and Senior (15+). Your child's age on 1<sup>st</sup> January determines which age group they are in for the 2020 year. EG if she is 7, she will be U8, if she is 8 she will be U9. Children don't switch age groups during the year.

Coaches continually assess your child to make sure they are in the right class to get the most out of their gymnastics. Your child's class time is printed on your fee letter – please make sure you arrive on time to avoid disrupting the class. Note: Some classes have changed this year so do check your fee letter carefully.

### **Uniform and Appearance**

A purple club leotard is compulsory for all U12 Gymnasts

Club Racer back vests are required for older gymnasts and girls training more than once a week, worn with club leggings/shorts or plain black leggings/shorts.

Our Lovely New Club Hoodies and club leggings complete our uniform and make our gymnasts look and feel part of our club at training, competitions and events.

The new club T-shirts given to all members at the end of last year are for warm up only and must be worn over your club leotard or club training vest.

Hair Fixed in a Bun No Earrings Club Leotard Bare Feet or Toeshoes

Reminder 1 - gymnasts must wear trainers to the gym – <u>not</u> school shoes, boots, sliders or heelies please! Reminder 2 - hair must be fixed securely in a bun, using pins and a net – no ponytails, bunches or loose hair!

#### Competitions

There are 6 levels to give everyone the chance to perform against gymnasts of a similar standard. Beginners and Novices start with Next Steps and Level 1, progressing to Level 2 after five competitions, Level 3 is for County and Regional standard gymnasts, Level 4 for National standard and Level 5 for British/international standard.

Not every child will do competitions, those that do need to have the ability and the desire to perform. Coaches will advise you when your child is ready to begin competing and what apparatus they will need, but if your child does not want to do competitions and just wants to do gymnastics for fun that is perfectly ok too.

Eligible gymnasts will get a letter with competition and entry details. Exact timings for competitions are only made available about a week before the event but generally you can expect your child to be there most of the day.

The club provides qualified judges and coaches for each competition, but parents are always needed as volunteers to help the event run smoothly. All offers of help are welcome!

You are expected to provide apparatus and a competition leotard for your child except where they are in their first year of competition or if they are competing as a group. Please ask advice before purchasing to make sure you meet the regulations as it can be quite expensive.











#### Coaching, Judging & Volunteering

We are delighted to announce our new Level 1 coaches passed their exams at the end of last year. Congratulations to Saffron and Ozleyis who have been recreational gymnasts for many years and are now assisting in our novice and recreation classes.
